Meters are read around the 25th of each month. For initial bills or new service, if service begins to provide 0-15 days of service, you will get a pro rated bill on the 1st of the following month. For a new service that provides more than 15 days of service you will get a normal bill on the 1st of the following month, however consumption may be somewhat less than normal. You can expect the bill around the first week of each month. Payments are due by the 15th or a 10% late fee is added to your account.
